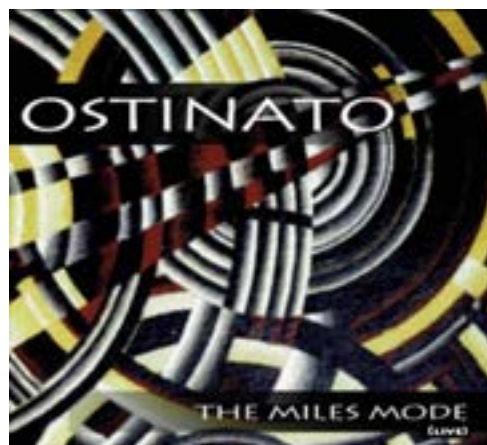

As one of the pioneer bands in the European jazz rock/fusion jazz movement in the 70s, OSTINATO was of course also inspired by Miles Davis. Each of the individual band Members in their own way: Tommy Böröcz was clearly impressed by Billy Cobham's rock drumming style, Andi Steirer was enthousiasted by the role percussion started to play in groove music, Rens Newland really loved the approach of John McLaughlin. The musicians who joined Ostinato later, such as Robert Riegler and Robert Schönherr, certainly included Miles in their playing, directly, or indirectly through Joe Zawinul. Likewise, the Ostinato wind section uses the same insights that Miles gained for the start of a more global, cosmopolitan style of playing. at this concert the group presented a selection of their own by Miles inspired works from their many albums, as well as some adaptations of Miles Davis tunes. Recorded live at Porgy & Bess, Vienna, Austria, Jan. 2023
